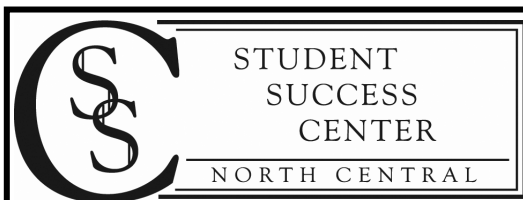




In an effort to fulfill our mission statement,

September 15th	Resume Writing The ultimate purpose of writing a resume is to obtain an interview. This workshop provides an energetic overview to writing quality resumes.
October 24th	College Writing In this workshop, we will explore how to decode what the professor is looking for, understanding how to maximize point values, outlining papers to increase ones speed of writing, and a variety of other tips for producing better papers.
November 8th	Choosing A Major This workshop will help students develop a strategy in declaring a major that integrates his or her interests and career goals. Areas of focus will include assessments as well as potential options otherwise overlooked.
December 5th	Test Taking Tips and tricks to guide students from preparing for the exam through the test itself.
